NOTICE TO COMPETITORS

WELCOME

The Eastport Yacht Club (EYC) is excited to host the J/22 Class for the J/22 World Championship during the 40th anniversary of the boat! During the event, feel free to utilize the EYC bar and restaurant. Just let your server know you are with the J/22 World Championship, and you will be able to pay via a credit card.

LAUNCHING, HAULING, & BERTHING

All registered boats will have free launching, hauling and berthing for the entirety of the event at either EYC or the Severn Sailing Association (SSA). The two clubs are adjacent and will work as one facility for the regatta.

Haul out will be assigned to competitors to reduce congestion at the hoists. Please email Kristen Robinson (contact information below) if you would like to haul out on Saturday. Preference will be given to out-of-town boats before local boats are hauled on Saturday. Between the two clubs (EYC and SSA) we have three (3) hoists, and we will do our best to accommodate all requests.

Slip assignments will be assigned at registration. Boats will be assigned a slip at EYC or berthing at SSA. All trailers will be stored at EYC, SSA, or on a property we are renting (the "Walker Property"). Competitors will have access to trailers and trailer boxes during the regatta. Please see the map of the properties attached at the end of this document. Please note that dock boxes will not be allowed on either property for security and safety reasons.

MEASUREMENT

Measurement will be completed by appointment. An appointment sign-up spreadsheet will be circulated via email soon.

REGISTRATION

Registration and weigh-ins will be open on Monday, 21 October, 0900-1800, and on Tuesday, 22 October, 0900-1800. All measurement procedures will occur at EYC.

POST-RACE ACTIVITIES

There will be free beer and lite fare at the skipper's meeting and after each day of racing. In addition, we intend to have a local panel of experts that will debrief the competitors after racing and at the competitors meeting.

ANNAPOLIS

We encourage all the competitors to get out and enjoy beautiful Annapolis. We will have one evening with a limited social so competitors can enjoy all Annapolis has to offer. Recommendations on dining will be available at registration and may be emailed to competitors before as well.

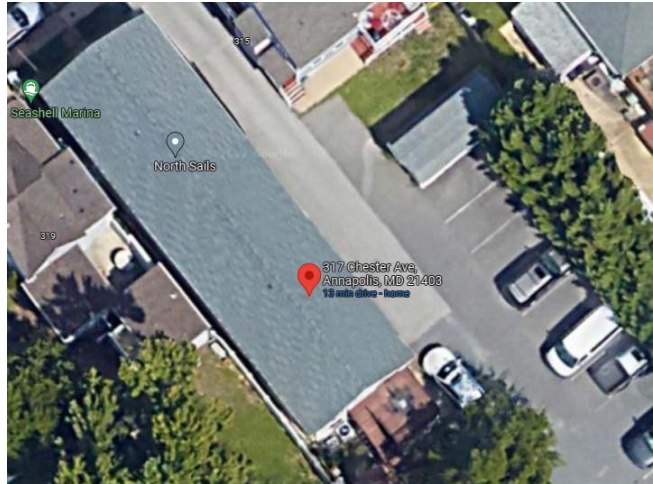
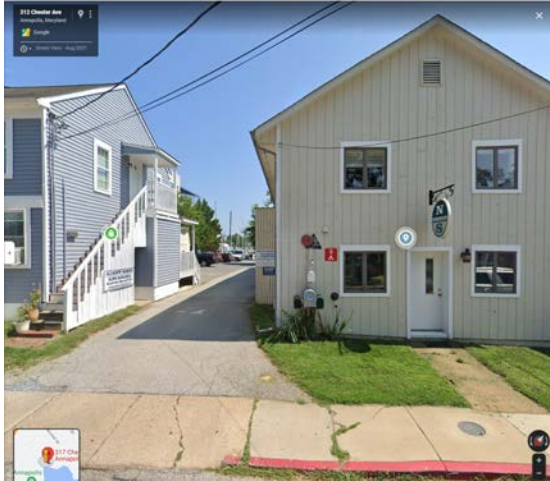


PARKING

There is no parking in the EYC lot for competitors without an EYC parking pass on their windshield. Also, there is no parking at the Yacht Haven lot across the street Wednesday-Friday between 0800-1700. Competitors may utilize the Yacht Haven lot outside those hours. **VIOLATORS WILL BE TOWED AT THEIR EXPENSE.**

OVERNIGHT SAIL REPAIR

North Sails will be open for overnight service and repairs for the duration of the regatta. If you need a repair, contact **Ridgely Mackenzie** at (443) 995-7188 before 1830. He will arrange pick up, and all completed sails will be placed in the North Sails drop box (see diagram below). Overnight service cannot be guaranteed if Ridgely is contacted after 1830. The North Sails loft is located at 317 Chester Avenue in Annapolis - about 5 blocks away from EYC.
